Real Name: Jorge Mario Bergoglio

Born: December 17, 1936, in Buenos Aires, Argentina

Died: April 21st 2025

Role: Pope of the Roman Catholic Church (2013-2025)

Motto: Miserando atque eligendo (By having mercy and by choosing him)

Who Was Pope Francis?

Pope Francis was the **266th Pope** of the Catholic Church and the **first Pope from South America**. He became Pope in **2013**, after Pope Benedict XVI resigned. He chose the name "Francis" to honor **St**. **Francis of Assisi**, who loved peace, the poor, and God's creation.

What Did He Do?

- He showed great kindness and humility, always caring for the poor and the lonely.
- He reminded everyone that God loves all people, no matter who they are.
- He cared deeply about our Earth and asked us to look after it.
- He worked hard to bring peace, forgiveness, and joy to the world.

Why Do We Remember Him?

We remember Pope Francis for his **gentle heart**, his **big smile**, and his **love for Jesus and the Church**. He helped many people feel closer to God and showed us how to live with love, faith, and hope.


