- Cake, Cookie or jelly

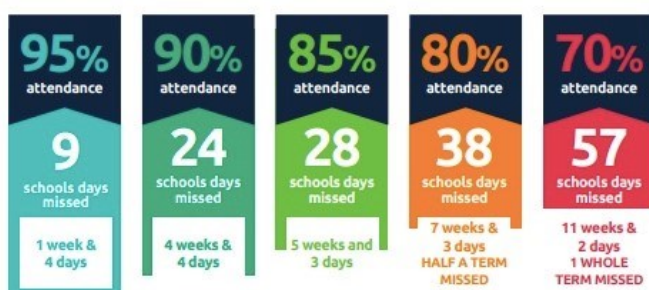
Please book as normal via School Grid if you want your child to have this.
